

## HOW TO MIX COBRA WITH WATER?



Cobra is an artist quality oil paint that is water mixable. To allow oil and water to mix, an additive is needed. This additive helps to form a stable blend of small oil droplets in water. This blend is called an emulsion. The additive is known as an emulsifier. The result is a water mixable paint that turns waterproof after drying.



There are two ways of mixing the paint with water. Adding just a bit of water to the paint makes the paint somewhat thinner.



When adding a bit of paint to lots of water, the result is a very thin and transparent paint, thereby achieving a water colour effect. This transparency depends, of course, on the amount of water and the opacity of the paint used.
